Fasadgruppen to carry out energy renovation on multi-family residential properties in Linköping for Riksbyggen

Fasadgruppen's subsidiary FRONT has signed a contract with Riksbyggen for an extensive energy renovation to a large tenant-owner association in Linköping.

The tenant-owner association comprises several buildings that were constructed in the 1950s. Like many other properties from the same period, they are in need of exterior renovation and energy efficiency measures. As part of the project, the façades and balconies will be renovated, roofs and windows will be replaced and FTX ventilation using the SmartFront method will be installed. As the buildings are considered particularly valuable from a cultural-historical perspective, there are strict requirements on the execution and that no distortion occurs. The work will be carried out over three years in six phases, and the order value amounts to approximately SEK 159 million.

Peter Polland, Business Area Manager Fasadgruppen NorthEast said: "Together with Riksbyggen, we are proud to be able to help another large tenant-owner association with an extensive renovation. In this project, the association has opted for a holistic approach that will result in greatly improved energy performance, reduced radon and a more comfortable living environment."
