

QleanAir delivered cleaned indoor air equivalent to 10.22 Ericsson Globe Arenas per hour by the end of the first quarter

This corresponds to 4.45 (4.26) billion m³ of cleaned indoor air per month at the end of the first quarter of 2021 compared with the end of 2020.

QleanAir measures the volume of cleaned indoor air worldwide on an ongoing basis and reports quarterly the volume corresponding to the number of Ericsson Globe arenas.
