Pierce's chairman Ketil Eriksen informs that he is not available for re-election at the 2022 AGM; the Nomination Committee proposes board member Mattias Feiff as successor

Ketil Eriksen, chairman of the board of Pierce Group AB (publ), has today informed the Nomination Committee that he will not be available for reelection at the company's Annual General Meeting in May 2022. The Nomination Committee has decided to propose board member Mattias Feiff as new chairman.
