

Wirtek Presents 2026 Guidance with Expected Solid Earnings Growth

Ahead of the publication of its annual report tomorrow, March 18, Wirtek has presented its expectations for the new financial year, 2026.

Wirtek expects to achieve revenue of DKK 65–70 million in 2026, corresponding to growth of 1–9% compared to revenue in 2025. Operating profit measured by EBITDA is expected to reach DKK 3–6 million, corresponding to growth of 76–253%. The company thus expects a solid improvement in margins, with the EBITDA margin projected to reach 4.3–9.2% compared to approximately 2.6% in 2025.

For the 2025 financial year, revenue amounted to DKK 64.3 million, while EBITDA totaled DKK 1.7 million. This is in line with the company's most recently communicated expectations of revenue between DKK 64–69 million and EBITDA of DKK 1–5 million. However, the result is in the lower end of the range, and full details will be presented in connection with the annual report.

The outlook for 2026 reflects a continued cautious market environment, particularly within the services business, where customer demand remains affected by macroeconomic uncertainty and ongoing productivity initiatives. In addition, the outlook assumes a gradual stabilization of activity levels throughout the year.

At the same time, the company continues to prioritize investments in AI, which are expected to support long-term growth and profitability, although they will impact costs in the short term.
