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Modulight Corporation: Composition of the Board of Directors and resolutions of the Board's organizational meeting

Mr. Liljeroos holds a degree in Business Administration and General Management from Uppsala University.

Timur Kärki has been the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Gofore Plc since 2019; a member of the Board of Directors of Finland Chamber of Commerce since 2021; a member of the Board of Directors of Technology Industries of Finland since 2019; and a member of the Board of Directors of Navakka Group since 2018. He has also acted in Board of Directors of Ilves-Hockey Oy since 2017. In addition, Mr. Kärki has acted as CEO between 2010 and 2019, Head of Project Management between 2007 and 2010, and System Developer between 2002 and 2007 at Gofore Plc; Chief Technology Officer at Wireless Artificial Intelligence Services Ltd between 2001 and 2002; Production Manager and Senior Software Specialist at Tietovalta Ltd between 1999 and 2001; and Software Engineer at Sonera Medialab between 1997 and 1999. Kärki holds a Master of Science degree in Software Systems from Tampere University of Technology.

Pia Kantola has been a member of the Board of Directors of Variantum Ltd since 2020.
