

Niam completes acquisition of Project Flora from JM in Järfälla. Stockholm

Niam has completed the acquisition of Project Flora, a newly developed residential asset located in Söderdalen, Järfälla. The acquisition from JM was signed in June 2024, closing occurred in June 2025.
