

Niam signs lease with Newton for new education hub in Stockholm's Hamnkvarter

Niam has signed a lease agreement with Newton Kompetensutveckling, one of Sweden's leading private education providers, for premises in the EQ Sthlm property, part of Stockholm's waterfront district, Stockholm Hamnkvarter.

Newton Kompetensutveckling is an education group that brings together several strong brands: SIH, Performing Arts School, and Dansforum.
