

Alzinova AB announces subscription commitments corresponding to 26.6 percent of outstanding warrants of series TO3

Alzinova AB ("Alzinova" or the "Company) announces today that the Company has received subscription commitments from larger holders of warrants of series TO3 (the "Warrants") including members of the Company's Board of Directors and management group as well as founders of the Company.

The subscription commitments received from the holders involves 3,454,992 Warrants, corresponding to 26.6 percent of the outstanding number of Warrants. In total, the subscription commitments correspond to an issue volume of approximately SEK 7.5 million and a majority of the subscription commitments are entered into by the Company's Board of Directors and management group. The subscription commitments are not secured through bank guarantees, restricted funds, pledged assets or similar arrangements.

The exercise period for the Warrants began on April 11, 2023 and continues until April 25, 2023.
