In August 2020, a collaboration was started for the development of 77 GHz radar antennas. The antennas developed during the initial project are now delivered to the customer who has evaluated them. The customer now chooses to deepen the collaboration with Gapwaves and orders a new project for design and development of 77 GHz radar antennas based on a new antenna specification.
