# Kollect on Demand Holding AB (publ) issues a trading update for February 2022

Today on March 16, 2022, Kollect on Demand Holding AB (publ) ("Kollect" or the "Company") issues a trading update for February 2022.

Kollect increases total revenue by 51% year-on-year.

Total Revenue increased by 51% compared to the prior year<sup>1</sup>. Revenue from continuing operations (extracting Waterford bin business) increased by 60% compared to the prior year.

#### **Recurring Revenue Activities**

Recurring revenues<sup>2</sup> in February 2022 were 48% higher than recurring revenues for February 2021.

Revenues from Domestic Bins were up 30% from February 2021, however they were down 3% compared to January 2022.

Revenues from Commercial Bins were 35% higher than February 2021 and 3% higher than January 2022.

The Commercial Skip business continued to perform well with revenues up 114% compared to February 2021 and up 32% compared to January 2022.

Commercial Junk was up by 229% compared to February 2021, and up 4% compared to January 2022.

The Company also introduced Commercial Grab hire service for commercial customers, a new product offering which was not available in 2021.



#### **BIGbin Revenues**

BIGbin<sup>3</sup> revenues in February 2022 were down 4% from February 2021.

#### Non-Recurring Revenue Activities

Non-recurring revenues<sup>4</sup> grew by approximately 58% compared to February 2021 revenues.

Domestic Junk, a high margin vertical within non-recurring revenues, was up 27% compared to February 2021.

Domestic Skips also were 155% higher compared to February 2021, although this is a lower margin vertical.

#### **Gross Margin**

The Company achieved a gross margin of 36% at a consolidated level in the month. This was 1 percentage point lower than the prior month as a result of the revenue mix.

## **Disposal of Waterford Bin Business**

On March 4, the Company announced the successful disposal of its Waterford bin business for approximately SEK 25 million, with all consideration paid upfront at completion.
