

Change in the number of shares and votes in Midsummer AB (publ)

Midsummer AB (publ) ("Midsummer" or the "Company") has, as previously announced, resolved on a directed issue of shares. The resolution was approved by the extraordinary general meeting on 24 January 2023. The directed share issue has been registered with the Swedish Companies Registration Office which has resulted in a change in the number of shares and votes in Midsummer as follows.

Prior to the directed share issue there were 67,741,409 shares in the Company, corresponding to the same number of votes. The directed share issue entails an increase by 1,658,536 shares and votes in the Company. As of today, there are 69,399,945 shares and votes in the Company.

Further, the resolutions of the extraordinary general meeting on authorizations for the board of directors regarding a directed issue of convertible bonds and one or more issues of shares with or without deviation from the shareholders' preferential rights, as well as the resolution to amend the articles of association, have been registered with the Swedish Companies Registration Office.
