The subsidiary C-RAD Imaging AB is since 1 January 2010 responsible for the manufacturing and the further development of the IBA diode detector program. The detectors are being used in in-vivo dosimetry and calibration of accelerator systems.

Last August manufacturing with a new detector chip was started. Most of the back log could before end of the year be shipped

Compared to 2012, the volume in 2013 is expected to remain unchanged.
