A broad presence of C-RAD systems at the annual oncology meeting ASTRO in San Diego, USA.

C-RAD AB with its three fully owned subsidiaries are all active in the field of radiation therapy. The company attended and exhibited at the 2010 ASTRO from October 31st to November 3rd in San Diego, USA. C-RAD presented new functionality with the Sentinel scanning system and the GEMini ED detector system.

The ASTRO congress in the US is by far the largest annual event in radiation therapy. Visitors from North America are of course dominant, however a large number of oncologists and physicists are also coming from Europe, Asia, and the rest of the world. It is a great opportunity to present new developments to customers and to meet with distributors and partners in the industry.
