The contract covers the final development phases of a new full scale product for use in a large re-signaling, and radical modernisation, project for a CBTC (Communications-based train control) system that address the expected increase in traffic over the coming years. This modernisation will bring faster, more frequent and more reliable journeys to millions of passengers using the network and supports the city's continued economic growth.
