I augusti skrev Hifab International tillsammans med partners ett kontrakt för det stora och prestigefyllda projektet ”Technical Assistance to Ministry of Public Works in Afghanistan”. Projektet syftar till en långtgående reform av landets vägsektor där den nuvarande motsvarigheten till Vägverket ska delas upp i en vägmyndighet, en vägfond för finansiering av underhåll samt ett Väg- och Transportforskningsinstitut. Hifabs ansvar är att bygga upp Transportinstitutet. Projektet finansieras av USAID, och Hifabs andel är ca 2 MUSD under en första 3-års period.
